

## Accessibility Requirements

1. All polling places shall conform to the accessibility standards adopted by the Secretary of State pursuant to the "Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act," P.L. 98-435. Section 34-302, *Idaho Code*.
2. The notice of election shall give information about the accessibility of the polling places. Section 34-602, *Idaho Code*.
3. Help America Vote Act, P.L. 107-252, Sec. 261(b). Counties may receive grant money from the State, Health and Human Services (HHS) Grants, to be used for individuals with disabilities including the blind and visually impaired for the following purposes:
  - Making the polling place accessible.
  - Providing privacy and independence in voting.
  - Providing information about the accessibility of polling places.
  - Providing outreach programs about the availability of accessible polling places.
  - Train election personnel how best to promote the access and participation of individuals with disabilities.
4. Help America Vote Act P.L. 107-252, Sec. 301(2)(3). The voting system shall:
  - Be accessible for individuals with disabilities, including the blind and visually impaired, that provides the same opportunity for access and participation including privacy and independence as other voters.
  - One direct recording electronic voting system or other voting system equipped for individuals with disabilities must be at each polling place.
