

PAPER BALLOTS ASSISTANCE TO THE VOTER

- (1) The handicap accessible voting unit should be demonstrated. This unit will allow individuals previously requiring assistance to vote independently.

Whether the voter chooses to use the handicap accessible voting unit or vote on the regular ballot, the choice of voting with or without assistance shall be left to the voter. A voter may find that assistance is required on the accessible voting unit once they begin to vote.

- (2) If any registered elector, who is unable by reason of physical disability or other handicap to record his vote by personally marking his ballot and who desires to vote, then and in that case such elector shall be given assistance by the person of his choice or by one of the election clerks. Such clerk or selected person shall mark the ballot in the manner directed by the elector and fold it properly and present it to the elector before leaving the voting compartment or area provided for such purpose. The elector shall then present it to the judge of election in the manner provided above. (34-1108, I.C.)
