

## Role Play Instructions

- The following review is designed to help poll workers manage key situations they may encounter at the polls.
- The Clerk or a trainer should facilitate the review session.
- Have the poll workers set up a typical poll for your county.
- This poll “set up” should include all necessary equipment and supplies (i.e. tables, election placards, Official stamp, stamp pad, example poll book(s), example ballots, etc.
- Ask for volunteers to “play” each position on the election board. Assign positions if necessary. Other poll workers will play the voters as they enter the exercise. Rotate poll workers through as many positions as possible.
- Begin the role play by asking poll workers to demonstrate the voting procedure as described in the Procedural Manual for your county.
- Pass out the review and begin the exercise.
- After each scenario, discuss the exercise and the reasoning behind the correct procedure based on election law.
- Many situations are not covered by the following scenarios. Please develop your own versions and record actual incidents that have or may occur this year at your polling places and email them to the Election Division for inclusion in the next edition of this training manual.
