

1	Election Day Registration	Election Day Registration Manual (EDR-2) Elector in Proper Precinct	34-408A
	If the voter is not in the correct precinct to register, use the precinct map to find the correct precinct		
2	The voter completes the Voter Registration Card - Check all 10 boxes		34-408A
	Election Day Registrants select a Party Affiliation or remain "Unaffiliated". Party Affiliation does not apply to the General Election but will for the Primary Election in 2014.		34-404(2)
3	ID in Precinct to Register	Election Day Registration Manual (EDR-2) Personal Identification Requirement	34-408A
	Acceptable forms of ID are an Idaho driver's license, an Idaho ID card, a U.S. Passport or government photo ID, a Tribal photo ID, or a current student photo ID.		
	Or a photo ID with any document that has a valid address in the precinct		
	Acceptable Documents - Utility bill, bank deposit slip, credit card statement, auto registration, rental agreement, any document with name and current residence address. Student ID with fee statement with address in precinct.	Election Day Registration Manual (EDR-2) Providing Proof of Residence	34-408A (1), (2), (3)
4	Check card is complete and stamp "Residence Verified"	Election Day Registration Manual (EDR-2) Providing Proof of Residence and Complete the Card
